

Note:

1. The B.Com curriculum is divided into four parts and contains different courses, The courses have been named after **AECC**: Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course; **DSC**: Discipline Specific Course; **SEC**: Skill Enhancement Course; and **CC&EC**: Co-curricular and Extra-curricular Activities
2. A practical is a 'hands-on class' which allows students to apply the theories learnt in the class room. One hour practical class is equal to one hour theory class and the class is managed by a single teacher. Practical classes may be conducted in the Business Lab or in Computer Lab or in the class room depending on the requirement. Experienced and Competent subject teachers may be allotted the practical workload.
3. IA marks for practical on skill development subject shall be awarded on the basis of practical records submitted by the student and on the basis of internal assessment tests.
4. Co-curricular and Extra-curricular Activities: A student shall opt for one of the following activities offered in the college, in all the four semesters of the undergraduate programme. The activity carries a credit each and will be internally assessed for 50 marks. The activities may include a) N.S.S. / N.C.C b) Sports and Games c) Physical Education or Activities related to Yoga d) Field studies / Industry Inplant Training. e) Community work such as promotion of values of National Integration, Environment, Human rights and duties, Peace, Civic sense etc. f) A Small project work concerning the achievements of India in different fields g) Evolution of study groups/seminar circles on Indian thoughts and ideas. h) Computer assisted/web-based learning and e-library skills
Evaluation of Co-curricular and Extra-curricular Activities shall be as per the procedure evolved by the university from time to time.
5. MIL and English are studied as per the circulations made by university from time to time. The contents of the syllabus and question papers pattern are also circulated from the university.

UG EXAMINATION GUIDELINES – MARCH/APRIL-2021

UG I, III & V SEMESTER REGULAR AND REPEATERS

This is to bring to the notice of all the Principals of UG colleges & Chief Superintendents of Examination Centers that the examinations of B.A., B.Com., B.B.A., B.C.A., B.S.W., B.Sc., B.Sc (CS), B.Sc. (ST) will be commencing from 24.03.2020. The Principals and Chief Superintendent are instructed to conduct the exams as per latest time table available on www.rcub.ac.in website. Also requested to ensure strict compliance of the instructions mentioned herein below:

I. APPOINTMENTS:

1. The Principals of Affiliated colleges of Rani Channamma University, Belagavi shall be appointed as the Chief Superintendent automatically. **They are not supposed to shift this responsibility to others.** In case of emergency, with prior approval from the Registrar (Evaluation) Rani Channamma University, it may be assigned to next senior most staff.
2. The Chief Superintendent shall appoint Junior Supervisors from the members of the teaching staff of the college and also from tagged colleges to the exam center (as per the circular of Commissioner of Higher Education, May 2011).
3. The University will appoint one **External Deputy Superintendent, who shall be reporting to the center one hour before the commencement of examinations.**
4. In case the number of students appearing for examination crosses 750, the Chief Superintendent will appoint one Additional Deputy Superintendent (Internal), with due intimation to the Registrar (Evaluation) Rani Channamma University, Belagavi.
5. It may be noted that the examination work is mandatory under Karnataka State Universities Act 2000. In case any teacher remains absent for examination duties, Chief Superintendent/Principal shall report to the Registrar (Evaluation) Rani Channamma University, Belagavi recommending for suitable action.
6. The Chief Superintendent shall contact nearest police station and health center where the exam center is situated and request for police security & health assistance in advance.

II. CONDUCTING EXAMS:

1. Principal/Chief Superintendents shall prepare center time-table using university time-table. A copy of the center time-table should be given to vigilance squad when they visit the center.
2. Hall Ticket bearing the photograph of the candidate, subjects, QP (Question Paper) code will be printed by using OASIS software and the same shall be issued to the eligible candidates duly signed by the Principal of the colleges. The Principal should verify attendance, eligibility, syllabus & appearance details before issuing hall ticket to the candidate. For any lapse in issue of hall tickets, the principals of respective colleges will be held responsible.
3. Exam centers should arrange the required number of blocks to accommodate the students. **Each block shall have maximum of 30 candidates and the center is strictly instructed to follow COVID19 guidelines issued by Govt. of Karnataka and Rani Channamma University.**
4. The **seating arrangement should be made according to the university registration numbers** as indicated in the Invigilators dairy downloaded from OASIS.
5. No candidate shall be allowed to sit arbitrarily in any of the blocks other than allotted to him / her. Such seating arrangement will be considered as encouragement for malpractice in the examination.
6. The decision of the **MALPRACTICES AND LAPSES ENQUIRY COMMITTEE** (MPLEC for short) on students involved in MPC in the earlier exams, which is already communicated to the concerned college and student, should be strictly followed by the Chief Superintendent / Principal.

III. DUTIES OF ROOM INVIGILATORS:

1. The Chief Superintendent / Principal shall instruct Room Invigilators to maintain decorum of Examination and should have strict vigilance in the Block / Room allotted.
2. The Room Invigilators should ensure that all candidates are possessing Hall Tickets.
3. They have to ensure that the candidates have written their name (in the space provided), registration number and center code on the answer script on front page only and legibly.
4. **It may also be ensured that the candidates are forbidden to write their names, marking, making signs for identification etc., in any part of the answer script other than front page.**
5. The Room Invigilators should ensure that candidates have written their Registration number on the Question paper in the space provided.
6. The Room Invigilators should ensure that all the candidates are writing the relevant question paper as indicated in the Hall Ticket.

8. In case of OMR sheets, Room Invigilators should verify the sheets and ensure that all the details are filled / marked / shaded properly and all the instructions given in the OMR sheet is followed.
 9. Rough work may be allowed on any back page of the answer book. But in case OMR answer book rough work should be done in the space provided in the question booklet.
 10. The Room Invigilators are provided computer generated Invigilator's diary to enter answer script numbers and shall obtain the signatures of the candidates appearing.
 11. **The Room Invigilators are required to ensure all the answer booklet numbers of allotted candidates are entered in invigilator dairy. Absentee numbers are rounded off. The seat numbers of candidates involved in malpractices are marked with red ink as MPC.**
 12. Students who are caught in MPC by the squad team should be allowed to write subsequent papers and other exams. However, they have to appear before the MPLE Committee of the University and its decision will be binding on them.
 13. The Room Invigilators are required to prepare the **Invigilators Diary in triplicate** and the same shall be countersigned by Chief Superintendent.
 - a. *First copy should be sent to valuation center along with answer scripts bundle.*

 14. The Room Invigilator should handover the Answer scripts after the examination is over to the Chief Superintendent / Deputy Superintendent (External) / Additional Deputy Superintendent (internal) along with Invigilator's dairy.

IV. PACKING OF ANSWER BOOKS:

1. The Chief Superintendent / External Deputy Superintendent shall pool all the answer scripts by each course, subject-wise / QP Code-wise.
2. **Absent & MPC detail should be entered in OASIS before generating daily report.**
3. **Bundle dispatch details should be entered in OASIS and packing sheet must be pasted on the bundle before dispatch without fail.**
4. **Duly filled appearing list and daily report should be sent to the valuation center along with the answer bundles.**

8. In case of OMR answer books, care should be taken while collecting and packing. OMR should not be folded, pinned. Keep the OMR sheets serially in a plastic bag and place that in between card sheet, so that they will not get fold.
9. **The Chief Superintendent / External Deputy Superintendent shall send MPC answer books separately to The Registrar (Evaluation), Rani Channamma University, Belagavi along with reports and copying material by speed post.**
10. Write the correct name and address of appropriate and concerned Custodian of Valuation Center (as indicated below).
11. Place in the cloth bag candidate's appearance list, Q.P Code wise and separately for fresher and repeaters.
12. Chief superintendent / Deputy chief superintendent (External) shall ensure that the following details are mentioned correctly on the left-hand top corner of the cloth bag. (Paste OASIS bundle packing sheet)
 - a. Center Code & Exam Center Name
 - b. Examination date and Session
 - c. Subject name and QP Code
 - d. Course & Semester
 - e. Number of Answer Scripts inside the cloth bag
 - f. Number of packets out of total. (For instance, if there are 3 cloth packs, then indicate 1/3 on first pack, 2/3 on second pack and 3/3 on third pack)
13. It is duty of the Chief Superintendent and External Deputy Superintendent to see that answer books are sent by Speed Post / Registered Post to the valuation centers on the same day after morning session and next day after evening session and report it to the University immediately. **However, the Chief Superintendents of the local colleges in the valuation center shall handover the answer scripts bundle in person to the valuation centre and claim Rs 50 towards conveyance per exam session answer bundles.**
14. No. T.A. / D.A. are allowed for dispatch of answer script bundles.
15. **In case answer books are sent wrongly the Chief Superintendent/External Deputy Superintendent will be penalized Rs 5,000/-.**


